



GEAR BOX OIL 30 AND 40

Two multigrade gearbox oils meeting the requirements of API GL-1.

Many cars manufactured in the fifties and sixties specified engine oil (usually the same as that recommended in the engine) for use in the gearbox. Whilst it was convenient to offer this recommendation, no doubt a proper gear oil would have been a better alternative.

These two gear oils have been designed for this type of recommendation.

Application

Both oils can be used in vintage, veteran and classic gearboxes including those fitted with overdrives and those vehicles fitted with pre-selector gearboxes.

Gearbox 30 is an SAE 20W-60 oil designed for use where monograde 30 oils were originally specified.

Gearbox 40 is a 25W-70 oil designed for use where monograde 40 or 50 oils were originally specified.

- Do not contain friction modifiers so will not cause overdrives and pre-selector bands to slip.
- Do not contain EP additives so are compatible with synchro cones and other metal parts.
